

This Holiday Season Shop With Passports With Purpose And Help Build A School In Cambodia

Starting November 30, the public can purchase raffle tickets to the prizes on the Passports with Purpose website (www.passportswithpurpose.com/donate.html), specifying the amount of the donation (in \$10 increments). Prizes include travel gear, getaways, hotel stays and more. The donations are made through PayPal, where donors can use a credit card and are not required to have a PayPal account. Donations are received directly by the America Assistance for Cambodia (AAfC). The online fundraiser ends on December 21, 2009 and prize winners will be announced on January 5, 2009.

There over 50 travel bloggers from around the world who have agreed to participate by securing a prize for the PwP fundraiser and who are encouraging their community of readers to buy one or more raffle tickets.
