Now with the approval of Micro-Needle Rollers for cosmetic dermatologists, Cosmetic Skin and Surgery Center has enhanced its Combination Therapy program with the addition of the Micro-Needle Roller.

Dr. Rapaport uses the Micro-Needle Roller over Acne Scarred skin to create microscopic punctures into the dermis. "These rollers when used properly stimulate the release of growth factors that, in turn, trigger the production of elastin and collagen" says Dr. Rapaport - a renowned Cosmetic Dermatologist in Englewood Cliffs, NJ. The skin reacts to any injury or damage by initiating the healing process. By Microinitiating this repair mechanism, the skin continues healing until the process is complete.

The skin typically accepts that scars are fine, however with a gentle reminder caused by the Micro-Needle Roller, the skin is stimulated to continue the healing process until the body has also mended itself. This process of skin remodeling can continue for months after each Micro-needle Roller session, however, detectable changes can be seen within a week or two! The skin naturally renews itself every forty days, so if you persevere, the changes can be fast and dramatic.

Dr. Rapaport believes that Cosmetic microneedling with a Micro-Needle Roller may be carried out safely on all skin types and all colors of skin. The epidermis and melanocytes in the basal area of skin aren't damaged, so the possibility of post inflammatory hyper pigmentation is diminished.

Dr. Rapaport often combines the Micro-Needle Roller with the Fraxel laser. During the same session both modalities are utilized. He believes that the two methods are synergistic since they work in a similar way.
