Sandals' intention was to levy this surcharge retroactively regardless of whether the client had already booked or not. Concerns were largely targeted at the potential "blindsiding" of clients who were not forewarned of a surcharge before booking.

"No one disputes the very real challenge of meeting escalating energy costs" stated Sandals Chairman Gordon "Butch" Stewart, "but we respect and highly value the opinion of our travel partners who are on the consumer front lines. We always want to do what is in their best interest and therefore after much discussion with them, we feel that now is not the time to enact this new policy."

Jason True, President of TotallyTrips.com (http://www.totallytrips.com/sandals.html), applauded Sandals and Mr. Stewart in their willingness to listen to and understand the concerns of the front line agents. "Energy costs are having an increasingly harsh impact on the travel industry", commented Jason. "Everyone is trying to figure out how to stay in business while faced by surmounting fuel and energy costs and a lagging economic forecast. Our job as a front line agent is to protect the interest of the consumer while working with the vendors to deliver the best available product. Sandals has always worked with the agent to accomplish that common goal."
