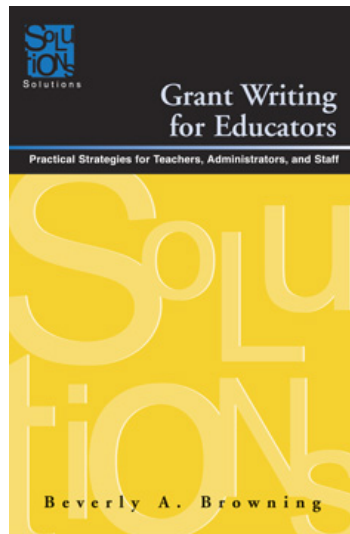


Grant Writing for Educators Workshop Saturday, November 6, 2010 - Las Vegas, NV
