



Auspit Outdoor Rotisseries to Compete at World's Largest BBQ Competition

While many competition BBQ teams utilize high-tech, dedicated BBQ trailers, the "Jonny Rotisserie and the Auspитеers" team will be returning to the origins of barbecue, cooking all of their entries using a rotisserie spit over an open fire pit.

"The cavemen were on to something" said Jonny Rotisserie, Chief Kangaroo at Auspit Outdoor Rotisseries, "they had a stick, some meat and a fire. This is how barbecue began."

Auspit (<http://www.AuspitBBQ.com>) is a lightweight, portable, cordless rotisserie which can turn up to 18 pounds of delicious meat, vegetables and seafood using just two D-sized batteries. The team will also be using the Auspit accessories Spitmate rotisserie baskets and Rib-o-Lator rotisserie trays (<http://www.auspitbbq.com/accessories.html#spitmate>) to round out their cooking arsenal.

With up to 500 teams competing, the American Royal is the world's largest BBQ competition, making it one of the toughest cooking contests on the planet. The Jonny Rotisserie and the Auspитеers team will be entering all four of the main meat categories: chicken, pork ribs, pork shoulder and beef brisket, plus the extra side categories of potatoes, vegetables, and dessert.

Jonny Rotisserie commented, "We are excited to test our mettle amongst the best cooking teams in the world. While the fancy rigs most competition teams use do a fantastic job, the cooking part of the action is all hidden away in secretive smokers. Where's the fun in that? Win, lose or draw anybody watching us

will see exactly how it unfolds for us because it all happens out in the open. With Auspit, it's food and friends around the fire...it's a party!"

"The Royal is a great venue for BBQ fans to see the versatility of the Auspit. We'll be at site #623, right in the middle of the action. Come by and cheer us on!"
